



Locatable Address Correction Services (LACS^{Link})

A.B. Data offers LACS^{Link} as part of our suite of address hygiene solutions. The U.S. Postal Service introduced the Locatable Address Conversion System (LACS^{Link}) in September 2004 to provide a secure technology for address conversions other than a customer move.

LACS^{Link} technology enables business mailers to update their rural-style addresses electronically with new, locatable city-style addresses in areas that are undergoing 911 emergency response address conversions. Other types of conversions are applied when local municipalities make changes to their addressing schemes or the U.S. Postal Service renumbers Post Office boxes.

There are currently more than 5 million converted addresses in the LACS file.
